ADMISSION NOTICE

This is for the information of all desirous candidates that some Self-Financing Seats in various Undergraduate Degree Programmes across different constituent colleges are still vacant after the conduct of three rounds of counselling and the complete exhaustion of the complete merit list.

Therefore, the Vice-Chancellor has approved to invite fresh online applications for admission to the Undergraduate Programmes for the Academic Session 2025–26 for the Self-Financing seats only. Furthermore, a Special Round of counselling will be conducted for the filling up of these Self-Financing Seats. The important details for the counselling process and the seats are as under:

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination in **English**, along with any three subjects from the following: *Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics, Agri. Physics, Agri. Chemistry, Agri. Biology, and Agriculture* from a recognized Board with a minimum of **50% aggregate marks** (45% for SC/ST/Persons with Disability/Orphaned Children/In-service nominees of Himachal Pradesh Government) in the above subjects shall be eligible for admission.

Criteria for Admission

- The Self-Financing Seats shall be filled on the basis of the percentage of marks obtained at the 10+2 level in English along with any three of the above-mentioned subjects.
- The Self-Financing Seats are open for all at the **National Level**.

Application and Fee Details

1. All candidates seeking admission to any of the above-mentioned degree Programme are required to fill the **online application form** and pay the **non-refundable application fee** of ₹ 2200/- through the University's admission portal at www.yspuniversity.ac.in/ysp or through the QR Code.



2. Counselling Fee Requirement

- i) In addition, all the candidates who wish to attend the special round of counselling are required to pay the non-refundable counselling fee through the E-Shiksha Portal via the link/QR Code provided in Annexure-I and must bring the receipt of payment generated from the E-Shiksha Portal after successful payment.
- ii) Proofs such as Google Pay, PhonePe, or any other transaction screenshots will not be accepted.

Important Instructions for Counselling and Admission

1. Previously Applied Candidates

All candidates who had applied previously are required to submit a fresh application through the online admission portal by filling out the application form and paying the requisite fee in order to be considered for admission against the above-mentioned Self finance seats.

2. Responsibility of Candidates

The candidates are advised to thoroughly go through the Prospectus for admission to the Undergraduate and Master's Degree Programmes for the Academic Session 2025–26 before applying. No refund will be made once the application is submitted. It shall be the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility as per the prospectus before applying.

3. Cutoff for Appearing in the Special Round of Counselling

All candidates who have applied afresh through the online admission portal and satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria for admission shall be eligible to attend the counselling process.

4. Counselling Fee

Mere payment of the counselling fee does not guarantee seat allotment.

5. Seat Allotment Criteria

Seat allotment will be carried out strictly as per merit, availability of seats, and eligibility criteria detailed in the Prospectus.

6. Basis of Admission

Admissions through the Special Round of Counselling will be made as per the provisions contained in the Prospectus and subsequent notifications issued by the University.

7. Vacancy Status

The vacancies mentioned are tentative and may change on the day of counselling.

8. Official Updates

Candidates must regularly visit the University website for updates. No separate communication via email/SMS will be sent.

9. Mandatory Attendance

All eligible candidates shall be required to attend the Special Round of Counselling at *Dr. L.S. Negi Auditorium, Main Campus, Nauni (Solan)*.

10. Reporting Time

Candidates must report between **10:00 AM – 11:00 AM** for marking attendance on the day of counselling at the venue.

11. Appearance Before Counselling Committee

It is mandatory for all candidates to mark their attendance and appear before the Chairman of the Counselling Committee.

12. Non-Appearance Clause

Candidates who fail to appear before the Chairman after marking attendance will not be considered for admission.

13. Late Arrival

Candidates who arrive after the reporting time and present themselves before the Chairman of the Counselling Committee will be considered only for seat allotment against any vacancies available at that time.

14. Right of the University

The University reserves the right to make further amendments, if required.
